**Subject: Healy Clean Air Separator (CAS) Update**

Franklin Fueling Systems announced the ARB approval of Revision D EVR Executive Orders (EO) VR-201 and VR-202 in December 2007. Highlighted changes to these Executive Orders in Rev D included:

- Exhibit and IOM updates to reflect the new Model 9961H Clean Air Separator (horizontal vessel orientation) in addition to the previously listed Model 9961 Clean Air Separator (vertical vessel orientation)
- Exhibit and IOM updates to reflect that a Pressure/Vacuum Vent Valve is no longer included or provided as part of the Clean Air Separator Hardware Kit (shall be supplied by installer and ARB certified as part of the Phase I system)

Franklin Fueling Systems began shipments of the Model 9961H Clean Air Separator immediately after ARB approval. Both Model 9961 and Model 9961H Clean Air Separators are available to meet your installation requirements.

As of February 1st 2008, Franklin Fueling Systems will begin shipping both the Model 9961 and the Model 9961H Clean Air Separator without a Pressure/Vacuum Vent Valve included in the CAS Hardware Kit. After February 1st, the CAS Hardware Kit will include the Breather Assembly, 9466G Float Check Valve, and Locking Ball Valves (with Locks and Keys), as well as temporarily notification sticker. The notification sticker will be applied to the outside of the CAS Hardware Kit carton to aid in the identification of initial CAS units shipping without the Pressure/Vacuum Vent Valve included.
